

Hingham Tennis Club Leave of Absence Policy

- 1. Leave of Absence (LOA) status of up to two-years' duration can be applied for once in a Hingham Tennis Club membership. In the case of a family membership, it applies to the entire family.**

- 2. The maximum period for LOA is two years, covering two playing seasons. The minimum period is one playing season on LOA.**

- 3. Application for LOA must be received by the Hingham Tennis Club Clerk or Treasurer before April 15.**

- 4. No dues are required, nor are there playing privileges during a LOA. The membership certificate is redeemed by the Club for \$50.**

- 5. Reapplication to full membership in the Hingham Tennis Club by an individual or family with LOA status must be done before February 1 of the year following the allowed LOA period. Action on this application will be on a preferential basis according to available full-membership space. Upon readmission to full membership, the member will be required to pay \$50 for the membership certificate in addition to the applicable dues.**

- 6. A LOA status member who does not reapply in this time frame will be considered to have resigned from the Hingham Tennis Club.**

EXAMPLE:

LOA is applied for before April 15 and begins May 1, 2017, covering 2017 and 2018 playing seasons. Application for resumption of full membership must be made before February 1, 2019, to receive preferential action on readmission to full playing privileges or nonresident status (if qualified).
